



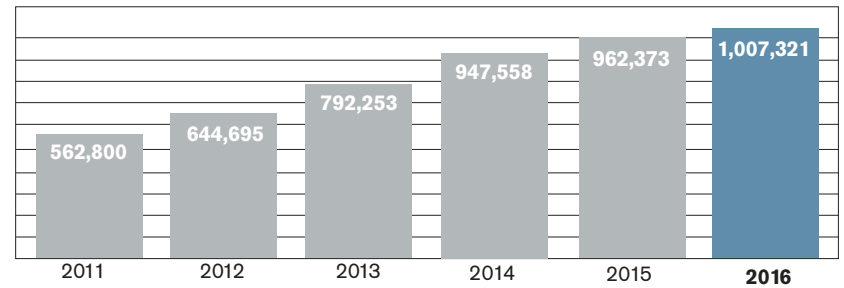

NISSAN GROUP IS INVESTING IN AMERICA

U.S. PRODUCTION GROWTH

➔ U.S. Production **has increased by more than 78 percent** since 2011, as Nissan Group continues to localize core-model production. Nissan built a record number of vehicles in the U.S. in 2016



MANUFACTURED IN AMERICA

- \$11 billion manufacturing investment in the U.S. since 1981, including \$3 billion since 2012
- Four manufacturing plants in America
- 15 million vehicles, 10 million engines and 87,000 lithium-ion battery packs proudly manufactured in the U.S.
- Nissan's Smyrna Vehicle Assembly Plant was the largest producing automotive assembly plant in North America in 2016

JOBS IN AMERICA

- More than 22,000 U.S. employees, including 17,000 manufacturing jobs
- 9,000 new jobs created since mid-2011 to support demand for products in the U.S. market
- \$1.3 billion in annual payroll
- Not a single layoff in more than 33 years of U.S. manufacturing operations
- Tens of thousands of additional jobs at 1,081 Nissan dealerships and 212 Infiniti retailers across the U.S.

SOURCED IN AMERICA

- Annual U.S. production exceeded 1 million vehicles for the first time in 2016
- \$14 billion in U.S. parts and materials purchases in 2016
- More than 300 suppliers in 30 states provide parts and materials to Nissan Group's U.S. manufacturing facilities
- More than 1.2 million U.S.-assembled vehicles have been exported since the start of U.S. manufacturing operations

FUTURE IN AMERICA

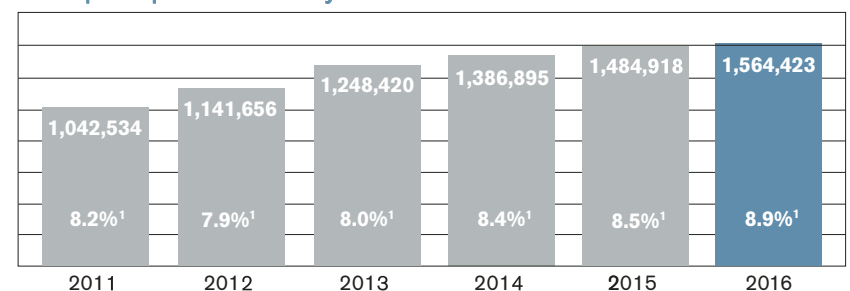
- A new 150,000-square-foot training and education facility adjacent to the Nissan Smyrna Vehicle Assembly plant will open in 2017. This public-private partnership between Nissan and the State of Tennessee will provide training programs aimed at preparing workers for jobs in advanced manufacturing such as engineering, robotics and manufacturing maintenance.

More than 33 Years of Manufacturing in America

Nissan sold its first automobile in the U.S. in 1958, with U.S. manufacturing beginning in June of 1983 as a white Nissan pickup truck rolled off the assembly line. More than 33 years later, Nissan has four U.S. manufacturing facilities capable of producing 1 million vehicles, 1.4 million engines, 1.4 million forgings and 456,000 castings annually.

U.S. SALES GROWTH

➔ In 2016, Nissan Group set an all-time U.S. record with 1,564,423 sales. Gains by key crossover and truck models such as TITAN (+80%), Murano (+38%), Frontier (+38%) and Rogue (+15%) drove Nissan sales up 5.4 percent for the year.
